THE BUYERS' GUIDE TO CALCULATING COST PER SQFT



Did you know that the average cost to build a house in Kelowna and the Okanagan is \$225 per square foot (plus or minus \$50/ sq ft)?

This is one of the most asked questions people have when they start thinking about building a new house. Knowing the average cost to build a house in Kelowna is essential in project planning, and plays a role in major decisions throughout construction.

A house is a complex structure with over a million components all coming together as one, which means careful considerations need to be taken during the planning phase to ensure the budget will stay on course.



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What factors affect the cost to build a house in Kelowna?

Before coming up with a finalized per square foot price, we need to look at the major factors that contribute to the overall cost, which include:

- Site Preparation and Topography
- Type of Home
- Interior Finishing
- Building and mechanical systems
- Underground services
- Premium Materials
- Roof design and complex architecture
- Municipality regulations
- Retaining Walls
- BC Energy Step Code Energy Performance Modeling

When calculating cost per square foot, we only use the living spaces. These are the current averages +/- \$50/sq ft for building a house in the Okanagan:

Barebones (studs) renovation/ remodel – \$200/sq ft Current Code Construction – \$225/sq ft Custom Luxury Home – \$300+/ sq ft

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As an example, if you wanted to know how much it would cost to build a 2,500 sq ft house in Kelowna, you could simply multiply the cost per sq ft number by the total sq ft of the living area.

For a Code Build Home, you would be looking at: Low end: 2,500 sq ft x \$175 = \$437,500 High end 2,500 sq ft x \$275 = \$687,500
